Learn the nuances and distinction between independent contractors vs. employees and how your business may be at risk. In Connecticut and elsewhere, the most important or significant consideration in determining employee or contractor status is the fundamental question of control. The Connecticut Supreme Court has ruled that the fundamental distinction between an employee and an independent contractor depends upon the existence or nonexistence of the right to control the means and methods of work. The test of the relationship is the right to control.
