

# Environment, Energy & Land Use Legislative Update

MARCH 28, 2011

The Joint Favorable ("JF") reporting deadlines for most of the committees of interest have passed. As a result, most of the bills of interest that are alive and in play can be identified and are listed in the table below. There are a few other bills that were referred to other committees with later JF deadlines (*e.g.*, Appropriations Committee – April 26, and the Finance Revenue and Bonding Committee – April 27) that may still receive a JF report.

Bills that have been favorably reported to the floor are assembled into a "file" which contains (1) the bill text with any substitute language approved in committee; (2) a fiscal note; and (3) a plainlanguage summary. Some of the bills have files already and the file numbers are listed below. For the rest of the bills, the initial files should be ready in the next two weeks (you can check on the availability of the file by selecting the "Bill Status" links below). The table below contains the following abbreviations: JF - Joint Favorable; JFS - Joint Favorable Substitute;CR - Change of Reference; and FL - Floor (of House or Senate).
