DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS



- 3rd consecutive year of significant gains in student achievement
- A total of 31 schools improved: 22 of them raised their overall school achievement index by more than 4 points
- Greatest increase in history in Reading:
 - 3rd Grade: 8% increase in students at Goal, 8% increase in students at Proficient
 - 10th Grade: 11.7% increase in students at Proficient
- Scores increased across all grades in Mathematics
